EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: On behalf of the Housing and Community Development Division (HCDD), Health, Housing & Human Services requests approval of Amendment #3 to Contract 11114 with Do Good Multnomah to provide supportive housing case management services at Clayton Mohr Commons for an additional year.

Clayton Mohr Commons is located at 314 Pleasant Avenue in the heart of Oregon City and provides permanent supportive housing to veterans. The property has twenty-four (24) housing units, comprising studios, one-bedroom units, and two-bedroom units, as well as a community room that hosts resident gatherings and facilitates the on-site provision of supportive services. All 24 units include project-based rental assistance vouchers to ensure that the units are affordable to veteran households at or below 30% AMI.

Do Good Multnomah has provided supportive housing case management services for the past several years at Clayton Mohr. Supportive services at Clayton Mohr Commons include promoting economic stability and self-reliance, assisting individuals in navigating and applying for additional benefits, and providing case management services tailored to meet the unique needs of each household.

The amendment value is \$333,783.00 for one year, bringing the new total contract value to \$937,981.43 for four years. This amendment is funded through Supportive Housing Services funds.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve the

Amendment to the Contract (11114) and authorize Chair Roberts or his designee to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

AMENDMENT # 3 TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS WITH DO GOOD MULTNOMAH Contract #11114

This Amendment #3 is entered into between **Do Good Multnomah** ("Contractor") and Clackamas County ("County") and shall become part of the Contract documents entered into between both parties on **August 10, 2023** ("Contract").

The Purpose of this Amendment #3 is to make the following changes to the Contract:

1. **ARTICLE I, Section 3. Consideration** is hereby amended as follows:

In consideration for Contractor performing Work during the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, County will pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$333,783.00.

Consideration rates are on a reimbursement basis in accordance with the budget set forth in **Exhibit A to this Amendment #3**, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference herein, and the terms of the Contract.

The total Contract compensation will not exceed \$ 937,981.26.
