**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:** The Office of Economic Development, in collaboration with Public and Government Affairs (PGA), established a business spotlight video program in the Spring of 2025. The first series of videos features the ten Business Development Grant recipients. These Video Spotlights will be made public on the County website, incorporated into the County's video media, shared by the Commissioners during business and other meetings and utilized by the business for their own professional marketing.

The Office of Economic Development and PGA have committed to delivering one video per month through the fall of 2026. The first was on October 2, 2025 and a new video is shared each month. The fourth in the series is Allied Technologies International. A shortened version of each video will be presented at Business Meetings to meet time constraints. The full version with business contact information will be publicly available after the business meeting.

Allied Technologies International (ATI), located in Wilsonville, is a high precision custom manufacturer producing components used in aerospace, semiconductors, telecommunications, and medical implants. ATI is a 2024 grant recipient that received \$50,000 for a capital project to purchase equipment which added new manufacturing capabilities.
