EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Clackamas County Department of Transportation and Development - Transportation Maintenance Division maintains 1,400 miles of roadways having to meet MUTCD standards for retro-reflectivity of roadway striping. This contract will provide traffic paint for centerline and edge line through May 31, 2028. Yearly maintenance is required to maintain safety on County roadways.

PROCUREMENT PROCESS: Approval of this purchase is being requested under the Local Contract Review Board Rule C-046-0400, Authority of Cooperative Procurements. The purchase will be made off cooperative contract # PO-10700-8436 with the State of Oregon ("Cooperative Contract"), through its Department of Administrative Services. A notice of Intent to Purchase the traffic marking paint was issued on May 21, 2024. No comments were received by the time of closing on May 29, 2024. The Cooperative Contract had an initial expiration date of June 2, 2024, and has been amended twice to extend its effective date through May 31, 2028.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff respectfully recommends the Board approve this purchase and authorizes Procurement staff to issue the PO on behalf of the County.

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Whereas, the Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) has authority to sign all contracts and any amendments or renewals of the same;

Whereas, Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”) Chapter 279A.200-220 and Local Contact Review Board Rule C-046-0400 permit Clackamas County to purchase goods and services using cooperative contracts;

Whereas, the State of Oregon, through its Department of Administrative Services, established a cooperative contract, Price Agreement PO-10700-8436, with Ennis-Flint, Inc. for the purchase of Road Paints (“Cooperative Contract”) and recently extended the effective date through 2028 by execution of Amendment No. 2 to the Cooperative Contract effective May 28, 2026;

Whereas, Clackamas County, Board of Commissioners previously authorized the Department of Transportation and Development (“DTD”) to purchase road paint under the Cooperative Contract in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 through the previous Cooperative Contract expiration date of May 31, 2026 (Board Order 2026-24);

Whereas, the previous Board Order 2026-24 erroneously stated that the authorization was intended to be effective through 2027, which was not possible at the time of adoption on April 9, 2026, due to the Cooperative Contract expiring on May 31, 2026;

Whereas, DTD is requesting additional authority to use of the Cooperative Contract with Ennis-Flint, Inc. to purchase Road Paint for an additional two years through May 31, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$800,000; and

Whereas, POs are issued directly through the Clackamas County Department of Finance’s management software with no signature required or available.

NOW THEREFORE, the Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners orders as follows:

1. The request to utilize the Cooperative Contract with Ennis-Flint, Inc. to purchase additional Road Paint through May 31, 2028 is hereby approved; and

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2. The Clackamas County Department of Finance is hereby delegated limited authority to amend the previously issued PO to increase the not-to-exceed amount by an additional \$800,000, for a total of \$1,800,000.
