November 4, 2025 Special Election:

Clackamas County Clerk and Elections conducts federal, state, and local elections for all voters living in Clackamas County. There will be a special election held on Nov. 4, 2025. **This is not a county-wide election.** Where you live determines what is on your ballot. If you are a registered voter in the cities of Gladstone, Happy Valley, or Portland; the Sandy Fire District; or the Lake Oswego, Oregon Trail or West Linn – Wilsonville school districts you should expect a ballot in the mail.

Important Dates:

- Sep. 8 at 5 p.m. Last day to submit a candidate statement or measure argument for inclusion in the voters' pamphlet.
- Oct. 8 10 County voters' pamphlets are delivered to all residential addresses.
- Oct. 14 Voter Registration Deadline. Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office open until 7 p.m. to serve voters. Voters can register online at oregonvotes.gov.
- Oct. 15

 Clackamas County Elections mails ballots. Official Ballot Drop Sites are opened where there is a special election.
- Oct. 20 Happy Valley Vote Center opens in the Happy Valley Library.
- Oct. 22 All eligible voters should have received their ballots. Contact Clackamas County Elections if you have not received your ballot.
- Nov. 1 Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office and Happy Valley Vote Center is open Saturday, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
- Election Day, Nov. 4 The elections Oregon City office and Happy Valley Vote Center are open 7 a.m. 8 p.m. Ballots must be mailed back with a valid postmark on or before Election Day or returned to an Official Ballot Drop Site before 8 p.m. on Election Day. Unofficial Elections Results will be posted at clackamas.us/elections starting at 8 p.m.
- Dec. 1 County Clerk certifies election.

Twenty-two Official Ballot Drop Sites:

There are twenty-two Official Ballot Drop Sites open in Clackamas County for the special election. These locations are available until 8 p.m. on Election Day Nov. 4 and are listed online: www.clackamas.us/elections/official-ballot-drop-sites

Two Voter Service Locations:

Each voter service location is staffed by sworn election officials. Voters can replace a lost or damaged ballot, update voter registration information, get voting assistance if they have a disability, get voting assistance in a preferred language, return their voted ballot, or vote in person.
