STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- **1. Prior to the Hearing.** You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and talk to County Staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- **2. Procedure.** The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence; the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of evidence that a violation exists or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney, to represent that at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney, they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- <u>3. Record of Proceedings.</u> An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- **4. Hearings Officer.** The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed, the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a final order or a continuing order. The Hearings Officer Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon Law. The Hearings Officer for Clackamas County is:

- <u>5. Right to Recess.</u> If, during the course of the hearing, the Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceedings be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- **<u>6. Right to Appeal.</u>** The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearing Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, the appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Diane Bautista, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent Sheri Cox mailing address is: 25162 S. Dubois Creek Ln., Estacada, OR 97023 and Respondent Chris Murray mailing address is: PO Box 945, Estacada, OR 97023.

2.

The Respondent(s) own/owns or occupies the address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint 25162 S. Dubois Creek Ln., Estacada, OR 97023, also known as T3S, R4E, Section 32, Tax Lot 01009, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon. The property is zoned AG/Forest District (AG/F) and is the location of violation(s) asserted by the County.

On or about the 7th day of August 2024 and the 2nd day of September, 2025 the Respondents violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a) Respondents violated the Clackamas County Solid Waste and Waste Management Code, Chapter 10.03 by storing inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles and miscellaneous debris. This violation is a Priority 3 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

4.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondents in the following manner:

Violation Notice dated August 7, 2024 and Citation and Complaint #2400289. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit D and I, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter.

Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondents from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty

against Respondents for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County

Commissioners. Said range for Solid Waste and Waste Management, Chapter 10.03 Priority 3

violation being \$500.00 to \$1,500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas

County Code;

3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to pay

an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County

Code; and

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to

reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties,

fines or fees that may be imposed:

5. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

History of Events and Exhibits:

July 12, 2024 Clackamas County received a complaint regarding occupied recreational

vehicles, occupied tent, multiple dwellings, structures built without permits, inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles and an accumulation of solid

waste.

July 15, 2024 Correspondence was sent to the Respondents regarding the alleged

violations. The alleged letter sent to Chris Murray was returned as

undeliverable.

August 5, 2024 I conducted a site inspection and there were multiple occupied recreational

vehicles, an old single wide mobile home, inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles, boat and solid waste. There are two houses on site –

25184 and 25162.

August 7, 2024 I conducted research and found that the two dwellings and single wide

mobile home are legal to remain. No violation for multiple dwellings.

August 7, 2024 Correspondence was sent to the Respondents for the occupied recreational

vehicles, solid waste and inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles

with a deadline of September 7, 2024 to abate the violations. The correspondence sent to Chris Murray was returned as undeliverable.

September 24, 2024 I conducted a site inspection and there was a tent, occupied RV with a car in

front and a second dilapidated RV white with orange stripe, multiple

inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles, dilapidated Bayliner, and

large tarp structure.

October 28, 2024 I met with the Respondent in the lobby and she said she lives in the

manufactured dwelling at 25184 and her sister only sleeps in the recreational vehicle in the driveway. Her granddaughter and 3 children live in the stick built home at 25162. The old single wide is only used for storage. She asked if she could have until July 2024 to clean up the property and I agreed to this

timeframe.

March 10, 2025 Exhibit F	Code Enforcement Specialist Jennifer Kauppi conducted a site inspection and met with the Respondent's daughter and granddaughter. She did not have the keys to the RV that is now located behind the house to verify if unoccupied, the greenhouse type structure was 25 x 25 in size being used for storage, tent not occupied and empty, the trailer at the end of the property not occupied, inoperable boat and debris.
June 10, 2025 Exhibit G	I conducted a site inspection and met with the Respondent on site. The RV in the driveway at 25184 is vacant and her sister has moved. The RV in the driveway at 25162 is vacant and belongs to her granddaughter Rebecca. On the side of 25162 is a burn pile that appears to being used to burn garbage. The tent is completely empty. I advised her to screen no more than 2 inoperable vehicles and screen or remove the debris. The occupied recreational vehicles violation is abated.
September 2, 2025 Exhibit H	I conducted a site inspection and inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles, boat and debris remained on site.
September 8, 2025 Exhibit I	Citation 2400289 was issued for the Priority 3 solid waste code violation for \$308.00. This citation was not returned to the County. This citation remains unpaid
November 4, 2025 Exhibit J	I conducted a site inspection and there were multiple inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles, miscellaneous debris and the burn pile was still full of garbage behind 25162.
November 11, 2025	The County referred this matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position by a preponderance of the evidence, the County may request a Final Order in this matter recommending the following:

- The imposition of civil penalties for the Solid Waste Code Violation of up to \$1,500.00 for date cited September 2, 2025.
- Payment for Citation 2400289 for \$308.00 issued on September 8, 2025.
- The administrative compliance fee of \$75.00 to be imposed from August 2024 until June 30, 2025 for a total amount of \$750.00
- The administrative compliance fee of \$100.00 to be imposed from July 2025 until the violations are abated. As of this report the total amount due is \$400.00. For a total amount of \$1,250.00.
- Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.



Occupied recreational vehicles constitute a violation of Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance, Title 12, Section 407.04. In order to abate the violations, you must complete one of the following **no later than September 7, 2024:**

- Submit a new and complete application for land use authorization, or;
- If the recreational vehicles are operable, currently licensed and registered to the
 person residing on the subject property, it may remain in stored condition. If you
 wish to store it on site please provide evidence it meets these conditions and
 schedule a site inspection to confirm, or;
- Remove the recreational vehicles from your property to an authorized location.

Solid Waste

An accumulation of solid waste constitutes a violation of Solid Waste and Waste Management Code, Title 10, Chapters 10.03.060 (A) and (B), as it provides a condition of unsightliness and is considered a public nuisance. In order to abate the violations, you must complete the following **no later than September 7, 2024:**

 Remove or screen all solid waste, including but not limited to equipment and furniture; vehicle parts; tires; scrap metal, or any other useless, unwanted or discarded material, or other similar non-putrescible solid waste or waste that is visible from the road or surrounding properties.

Additionally all putrescible (household) waste must be stored in a rodent proof container with a tight-fitting lid and removed to an authorized disposal facility a minimum of **once every seven (7) days.** Covering solid waste with a tarp or tarp like structure does not remove the items from violation.

Inoperable and/or Non-Currently Licensed Vehicles

Inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles constitute a violation of Solid Waste and Waste Management Code, Title 10, Chapters 10.03.060 (A) and (B), as it provides a condition of unsightliness and is considered a public nuisance. In order to abate the violations, you must complete the following **no later than September 7, 2024:**

- Remove the inoperable and/or not currently licensed vehicles from the subject property, and/or;
- Render the inoperable and/or currently unlicensed vehicles, operable and licensed, and/or;
- Place the inoperable and/or not currently licensed vehicles inside a permitted structure, and/or;
- Screen no more than two (2) vehicles from view of the road and surrounding properties, in accordance with the minimum screening requirements of the code (see Title 10.03.060 (C)). Please note: placing vehicles under tarps or tarp structures does not remedy the violation.

Important Notices

- Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- 2. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
- 3. Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. **Potential Fines and Penalties:** The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property: Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.














