EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Oregon Highway 224 (OR 224) is a part of the state highway system under the jurisdiction and control of the State of Oregon through ODOT. A MOU is required to document the shared understanding between Clackamas County and ODOT on the acceptance of certain properties obtained through the County's right of way acquisition process required for the Amisigger Road at OR 224 Project. ODOT refers to the project as the Amisigger Roundabout, which is the title of the MOU. Right of way that will be acquired for the project will be completed by the County and relinquished to ODOT at the completion of the project.

The intersection of Amisigger Road with OR 224 was recommended by the Community Road Fund Committee as a high priority congestion relief improvement project. The total cost of the project is \$5,675,465. Construction of the project is expected to be initiated during the fall of 2026.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff respectfully recommends the Board of County Commissioners approve and sign the attached MOU with ODOT for the Amisigger Road at OR 224 Project.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Project Name: Amisigger Roundabout

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between the State of Oregon by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "State;" and Clackamas County, by and through its elected officials, hereinafter referred to as "Agency," both herein referred to individually or collectively as the "Party" or "Parties".

RECITALS

1. By the authority granted in Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 190.110 and 283.110, state agencies may enter into agreements with units of local government or other state agencies for the performance of any or all functions and activities that a Party to the agreement, its officers, or agents have the authority to perform.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree to the following:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. It is the intent of State and Agency to document in this MOU, the States intended acceptance from Agency of certain property(s) shown and described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof. Agency agrees to relinquish said property(s) to State in accordance with the terms of this MOU upon its execution.
- 2. State and Agency intend that, if an impasse or disagreement should occur on issues pertaining to the MOU, a collaborative process will be initiated to resolve the difference. A collaborative process may be requested by either Party and will conform to the best practices for mediation, as prescribed by the Oregon Resolution Program.
- 3. This MOU shall become effective when all required signatures have been obtained and shall remain in effect for five (5) years when this MOU automatically terminates.
- 4. The terms of this MOU shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented or amended, in any manner whatsoever, except by written agreement signed by the Parties.
- 5. The terms of this MOU may be amended or terminated by mutual written consent of the Parties.
- 6. The foregoing Memorandum is a nonbinding proposal and is not and should not be construed as a commitment by either Party. Notwithstanding the signing or delivery of the Memorandum, any past, present or future actions; or approvals by either Party based upon this Memorandum, neither Party is under any legal obligation with respect

to the intentions outlined above and no binding commitment of any nature whatsoever will be implied.

- 7. This MOU is not intended to create a legally binding Agreement and is not a commitment by either Party.
- 8. This MOU may be executed in several counterparts (facsimile or otherwise) all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. Each copy of this executed MOU shall constitute an original.

THE PARTIES, by execution of this MOU, hereby acknowledge that their signing representatives have read this MOU, understand it, and agree to its terms and conditions.
