

Effective October 5, 2025, there is a vacancy in State Senate District 26 due to the resignation of Senator Daniel Bonham.

The Republican Party precinct committeepersons of State Senate District 26 met and chose nominees to fill the vacancy. The nominees chosen are:

The Appointing Authority must meet to appoint one person from the list of nominees.

The vacancy must be filled **no later than November 4**, **2025**, 30 days after the vacancy occurred.

In accordance with ORS 171.062 and ORS 171.064, when a vacancy occurs in a legislative district encompassing two or more counties, each county is entitled to one vote for each 1,000 of its electors or major fraction of 1,000 (more than 500 registered electors, but less than 1,000) residing within the district at the time the vacancy occurred. However, any county having electors in the district shall be entitled to at least one vote. Each county commissioner is allotted the following number of votes:

County	Number of Registered Electors	Votes per County	Number of Commissioners	Votes per Commissioner

Hood River	16,809	17	5	3.4
Multnomah	8,932	9	5	1.8
Wasco	14,637	15	3	5.0

These votes are apportioned to each county commissioner. If for any reason a county commissioner is unable to attend the meeting on October 23, 2025, that county commissioner's vote would not be cast. The votes are not reapportioned for the remaining county commissioners to cast.
