STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:

- (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and talk to County Staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
- (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
- (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.

2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence; the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of evidence that a violation exists or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney, to represent that at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney, they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.

3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.

4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed, the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a final order or a continuing order. The Hearings Officer Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon Law. 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, the Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceedings be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.

6. Right to Appeal. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearing Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, the appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Andrea Hall, Senior Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent Clinton Hurd's mailing address is: 44727 S Elk Prairie Rd., Molalla, OR 97038.

2.

The Respondent own/owns or occupies the address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint 44727 S Elk Prairie Rd., Molalla, OR 97038, also known as T7S, R2E, Section 06 , Tax Lot 700, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon. The property is zoned Timber District (TBR) and is the location of violation(s) asserted by the County.

3.

On or about the 3rd day of September, 2024 and the 28th day of March, 2025 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

- a. Section 406 of the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance by operating a campground without land use approval.

. This violation is a Priority 2 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

4.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner: Violation Notice and Citation and Complaint #2300035. A copy of the notice documents are attached to this Complaint as Exhibits D & F, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for the Priority 2 violation being \$750.00 to \$2,500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;

3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code; and

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

5. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

STATEMENT OF PROOF

History of Events and Exhibits:

January 30, 2023 Exhibit A	In response to a complaint, a letter was mailed to the Respondent alleging the operation of a private campground on the subject property without land use approval.
February 16, 2023 Exhibit B	A review of the website Hipcamp.com revealed that the campground, The Falls at Elk Prairie, is operating and is hosted by the Respondent.
August 30, 2024 Exhibit C	A review of the hip camp website revealed that the camp is still operating. Recent reviews of the campground reflect recent commercial activity on the property.
September 3, 2024 Exhibit D	A violation notice was mailed to the Respondent with a deadline to submit a land use application to the Clackamas County Planning Department or cease operating the camp by October 3, 2024.
March 28, 2025 Exhibit E	A review of the internet revealed that The Falls at Elk Prairie is still operating.
March 31, 2025 Exhibit F	Citation number 2300035 was issued in the amount of \$400.00 for the zoning violation. The citation was sent first class mail, and was not returned to the County, the citation remains unpaid.
April 28, 2025	I met with Walt Cate who is a friend of the Respondent. Walt understood that an approved Conditional Use is required to operate the campground. He said that the camp only has a few sites and is open from April to October. Walt indicated that he would talk with Planning regarding a reduced application fee and finances are an issue for the Respondent.
November 19, 2025 Exhibit G	A review of the hip camp website revealed that the campground is still operating but under the new name of Elk Falls Outdoor Retreat. There were also recent reviews which indicated the camping continues.

July 17, 2016
Exhibit H

A review of the internet revealed that The Falls at Elk Prairie is still operating with recent reviews.

July 27, 2026

The matter was referred to the Clackamas County Compliance Hearings Officer.

As the Respondent has not taken the necessary steps to abate the violation, he is benefiting financially from the violation and the violation is not due to conditions or circumstances beyond their control the County is requesting a Final Order in the matter and authorization to proceed to Circuit Court for further enforcement action.

However, if the Hearings Officer finds that there are mitigating factors in this case, the County would request a Continuing Order requiring that the Respondent either submit a complete Conditional Use application to the Planning Department or cease operating the camp no later than 30 days from the date of the Order.

The County will submit a timely Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:

- The imposition of civil penalties of \$750.00 to \$2,500.00 for the priority 2 Zoning violation for date cited March 31, 2025.
- Payment for Citation No. 2300035 for the Zoning violation dated March 28, 2025 totaling \$400.00.
- Assessment of an administrative compliance fee calculated at \$75.00 per month starting September 2024 to June 2025 subtotaling \$675.00. The County is requesting a reduction of \$300.00 in the assessed administrative compliance fee due to 4 months of inactive code enforcement activity subtotaling \$375.00.
- Assessment of an administrative compliance fee calculated at \$100.00 per month starting July 2025 through June 2026 subtotaling \$1,100.00. The County is requesting a reduction of \$800.00 in the assessed administrative compliance fee due to 8 months of inactive code enforcement activity subtotaling \$300.00.
- Assessment of an administrative compliance fee calculated at \$102.00 per month starting July 2025 through the date of abatement or date of Final Order subtotaling \$102.00. Total compliance fee of \$777.00

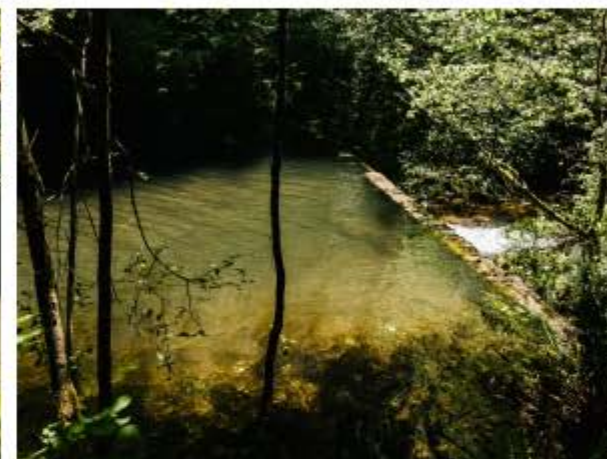

Important Notices

1. **Administrative Compliance Fees.** It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. **An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.**
2. **Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following:** (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
3. **Request for a Hearing:** If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
4. **Potential Fines and Penalties:** The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
6. **Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property:** Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.

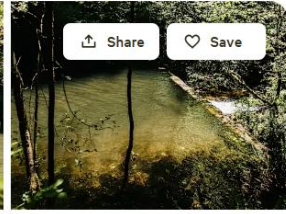
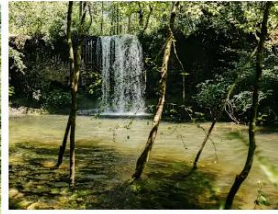

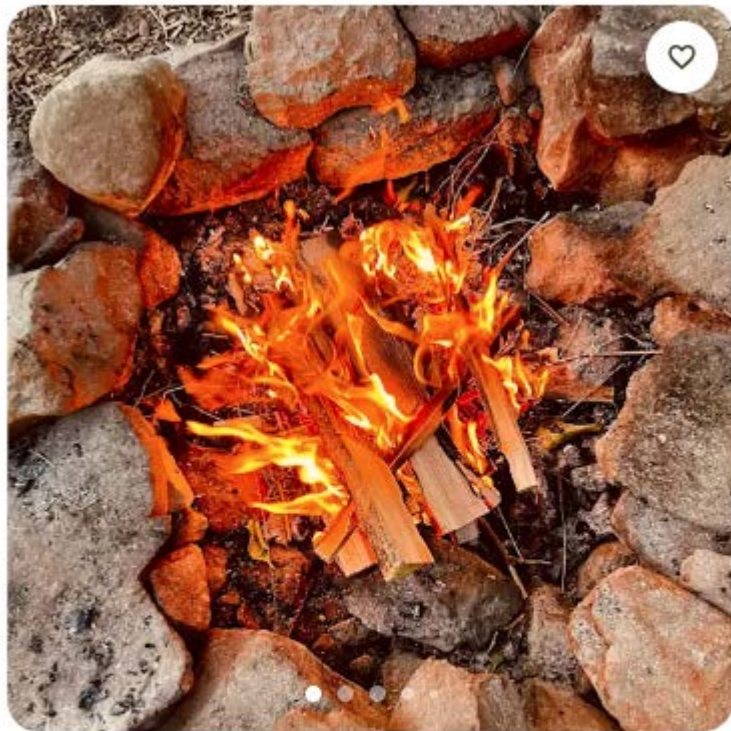
