Approval of a Contract Amendment with Unify for licensing and maintenance of telephone/voice data servers. Amendment Value is \$1,350,000 for 5 years. Total Agreement Value is \$2,700,000 for 10 years. Funding is through departmental cost allocation, which may include a small portion of Budgeted County General Funds.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Clackamas County Technology Services Department (TS) is tasked with providing high quality, feature rich and cost-effective voice services to the County Departments and Staff. This service is provided via the Telecommunications Division of TS. These voice services include management of several high-performance communication servers to provide local and long-distance telephone service as well as many other related features such as unified communications, integrated centralized Private Network E911, integrated centralized voice mail, integrated centralized automated attendant, four digit dialing to any County Agency and other services in a cost effective manner to the County. TS utilizes communication servers from Unify Communications Inc., a world leader in high performance, high-reliability communication systems.


Currently, licensing maintenance is up for renewal on all the Core Voice Servers. Continuing the licensing maintenance will ensure licensing compliance and continued high availability of these very dependable systems. Funding for this procurement is budgeted annually in Fund 747.

This contract has been reviewed by County Counsel.

Staff respectfully recommends approval of the contract amendment with Unify Inc. to continue licensing maintenance on all Core County Voice Servers. Staff further recommends the Board delegate authority to the Technology Services Director to sign agreements necessary in the performance of this contract.

**AMENDMENT #3
TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS WITH
UNIFY INC. (FORMERLY ATOS IT SOLUTIONS AND SERVICES, INC.)
Contract #4619 / Master Contract CLA-0917-01A**

This Amendment #3 is entered into between **Unify Inc.** (“Contractor”) and Clackamas County (“County”) and shall become part of the Contract documents entered into between both parties on **December 20, 2018** (“Contract”).

Background

- A. On December 20, 2018, Unify Inc. (formerly Atos IT Solutions and Services, Inc.) entered into a 5 year Contract with a total not-to-exceed value of \$1,350,000 via staff report.
- B. On September 19, 2019, the County approved a brand standardization to utilize Atos/Unify Equipment for the County’s Enterprise Telecommunications Network for 10 years.
- C. The total Contract value amount authorized under the approval of the 5 year Contract has been exhausted.
- D. On November, 11 2024, the Contract was extended through December 20, 2030.

The Purpose of this Amendment #3 is to make the following changes to the Contract:

- 1. Contract Consideration is hereby amended as follows:

In consideration for the Contractor providing goods and services for the extended term identified above, the County hereby authorizes an additional 5 year amount not to exceed \$1,350,000. Because this Contract is used on an as-needed basis, and the exact amount of goods and services the County may require is unknown, nothing herein shall be construed as a promise to pay Contractor the entire additional \$1,350,000.00 authorized under this Amendment #3.


