EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: This agreement offsets the cost of providing marine patrol enforcement services outlined in ORS Chapter 830 Small Watercraft. This includes coverage of the following waterbodies located within Clackamas County; approximately 30 miles of the Willamette River, All Clackamas River (Approximately 50 miles) including North Fork Reservoir, 50 miles of the Molalla River, 10 miles of the Tualatin and Pudding Rivers, Sandy River above Oxbow Park, and Lake Oswego, Timothy, Trillium and Harriet Lakes. CCSO receives a funding allotment from the Marine Board for the biennium. Clackamas County is not receiving an increase over each fiscal year primarily due to a decline in boater registrations throughout the State of Oregon.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of this agreement.
