EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The Office of Economic Development, in collaboration with Public and Government Affairs (PGA), established a business spotlight video program in the Spring of 2025. The first series of videos features the FY24-25 Business Development Grant recipients. These Video Spotlights will be made public on the County website, incorporated into the County's video media, shared by the Commissioners during business and other meetings and utilized by the business for their own professional marketing.

The Office of Economic Development and PGA committed to delivering one video per month over a 10-to-12-month period beginning October 2, 2025. A shortened version of each video will be presented publicly at a Business Meeting. The sixth in the series is Stumptown Coffee.

Stumptown Coffee Roasters is a Northwest-based brand producing roasted bagged whole bean and ground coffee as well as canned and bottled cold brew coffee. Stumptown is a 2024 grant recipient that received \$100,000 for a capital project to upgrade a Milwaukie building from a warehouse distribution center into a manufacturing facility to house the company's cold brew production.
