M., is a portion of the property relinquished by the Oregon Department of Transportation to the County via Deed No. 2023-19553 in fulfillment of a prior agreement under the provisions of ORS 366.290(3). Whereas, this matter coming before the Board at this time, and it appearing that, under the provisions of ORS 366.290(3), with the written agreement of the county in which a particular highway or part thereof is located, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) may, when in its opinion the interests of highway users will be best served, eliminate from the state highway system any road, highway, road segment or highway segment, after which the road, highway or segment becomes a county road or highway, and the construction, repair, maintenance or improvement, and jurisdiction over the road or highway will be exclusively under the county in which the road or highway is located; and

Whereas, in an agreement entered into on June 8, 2006, as amended on July 06, 2006, ODOT agreed to eliminate a portion of Multorpor Drive from the state highway system and transfer it to the County, and the County agreed to accept it as a county road; and

Whereas, in a deed dated March 21, 2023, and recorded as Document No. 2023-19553, Clackamas County Deed Records, ODOT relinquished to the County the following described property in fulfillment of the agreement:

All of those portions of the relinquished Oregon Department of Transportation property described in Document No. 2023-19553, Clackamas County Deed Records, situated in Government Lot 1, of Section 23, Township 3 South, Range 8.5 East, Willamette Meridian, lying north of the northerly right of way line of East Frontage Road, and adjoining the southerly lines of County Road No. 1406, being all of that property identified as County Road No. 3421 right of way depicted on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

Containing 49,418 square feet, more or less; and

Whereas, the County Road Official has submitted a written report, dated February 24, 2026, finding that acceptance of the property as a county road is in the public interest; and

Whereas, the Board, having read said report, has determined that such action is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners does hereby order as follows:

Section 1: The Board accepts the above described property, known as Multorpor Drive, as County Road No. 3421.


