Measure would dissolve Monitor Rural Fire Protection District and eliminate Monitor Rural Fire Protection District's permanent tax rate and local option levy.

Measure would take effect only if two separate measures for dissolution of Mt. Angel Fire District and formation of Mt. Angel-Monitor Fire District are also approved by voters. The proposed new district combines the existing Mt. Angel District and Monitor District boundaries into one. Both districts have been operating together under agreement. Dissolution will eliminate existing tax rates and the local option levy, replaced by a permanent tax rate of \$1.97 per \$1,000 of assessed value for the Mt. Angel-Monitor Fire District.

All employees, assets, and liabilities of Monitor Rural Fire Protection District would transfer to the new district. The plan of dissolution is available for examination at the County Clerk's office.

Dissolution effective December 31, 2026. January 1, 2027 new district provides fire protection and EMS services.

Explanatory Statement Dissolution of Monitor Rural Fire Protection District

If adopted, this measure will dissolve the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District. This measure will take effect only if all three related measures are approved by voters: formation of the new Mt. Angel-Monitor Fire District and dissolution of each of the two existing districts.

Fire protection and emergency services in this area are currently provided by the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District, one of two districts serving the combined community. The Monitor Rural Fire Protection District and the Mt. Angel Fire District undertook a multiyear process, including a feasibility study and engagement with community members and stakeholders, to review existing services and evaluate consolidating into a single district.

This measure is one part of that proposed consolidation. If voters approve all three measures, the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District would be dissolved and its territory would become part of the new Mt. Angel-Monitor Fire District, effective January 1, 2027. On that date:

- The assets, real and personal property, and reserve funds of the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District, which carries no bonded debt or long-term financial obligations, would transfer to the new district;
- The permanent property tax rate and local option currently levied by the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District would no longer be levied; and
- Fire protection and emergency services for the area would be provided by the new Mt. Angel-Monitor Fire District, governed by a five-member board elected at large at the November 3, 2026 election.

Property within the current Monitor Rural Fire Protection District would instead be subject to the new district's permanent property tax rate of \$1.97 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

If all three measures are not adopted, the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District would not be dissolved, the new Mt. Angel-Monitor Fire District would not be formed, and the Monitor Rural Fire Protection District would continue to operate separately under its current permanent tax rate and current service arrangements.
