**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**: The Clackamas County Public Health Division (CCPHD) of the Health, Housing, and Human Services Department requests the approval of Amendment #04, the Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas County Fire District #1 (CFD1) for medical direction. This amendment provides CCPHD with funding to provide medical direction services to Clackamas County Fire District #1. This includes developing a program to ensure they meet clinical state requirements and performance standards, and that CFD1 first responders adhere to the required protocols for providing EMS care.

The County works to ensure that CFD1 EMS providers meet Oregon State requirements for licensure and possess the knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform at the standards jointly determined by the County and the Agency. They evaluate each EMS provider's skill performance annually, provide case reviews, and conduct other agreed-upon educational activities while overseeing and directing training and quality improvement programs.

This amendment will accomplish the continued provision of emergency medical services and medical direction to CFD1.

Amendment #4 adds \$72,000 and extends the term through December 31, 2026.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve this amendment to the agreement (10449\_04) and authorize Chair Roberts or his designee to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

The Purpose of this Amendment #4 is to make the following changes to the Contract:

- 1. Section 1. **Term** is hereby amended as follows:

  The Contract termination date is hereby changed from December 31, 2025, to **December 31**, 2026.
- 2. Section 3. Consideration is hereby amended as follows:
  In consideration for Contractor performing Work during the extended term of this Contract,
  County will pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$72,000. The total Contract compensation
  will not exceed \$360,000.
