## Abbreviations

AoT = Ark of Taste variety; Slow Food Movement

AV = Adaption Variety aka Modern Landrace/Grex

F1 = hybrid. Do not save seeds from plants you grow from these seeds. They will not produce the same plant.

PPL = Native plant that is on the Portland Plant List

OSSI = Open Source Seed Initiative. OSSI was created by a group of plant breeders, farmers, seed companies, and sustainability advocates who want to free the seed! OSSI

works with plant breeders who commit to making one or more of their varieties available exclusively under the OSSI Pledge. If you see OSSI in a listing, the "pledge" in the next paragraph applies to it.

You have the freedom to use these OSSI-Pledged seeds in any way you choose. In return, you pledge not to restrict others' use of these seeds or their derivatives by patents or other means, and to include this Pledge with any transfer of these seeds or their derivatives.

This "copyleft" commitment ensures that the Pledge is transmitted with any further distribution of the seed or the seed of any new varieties bred from it. In this way, OSSI preserves the unencumbered exchange of plant germplasm for breeding purposes and guarantees the rights of farmers and gardeners to save and replant seed.

## Herbs

This table shows how many packets of each variety are available at Oak Lodge and Gladstone libraries and of those packets, how many are **Local** (locally grown) and how many are Adaptation varieties.

A packet may contain only a few seeds, or it may be stuffed with seeds. Typically, the locally grown seed packets have more seeds than the commercial seed packets. Note that when we receive more than one seed packet of the same variety and year from a commercial seed company, we combine them into one packet.

An **adaptation variety** is a locally grown, genetically-diverse, promiscuously-pollinated, survival of the fittest crop that fosters food security and community. It is a blend of many varieties and has incredible vigor. It is highly adaptable to a changing growing environment.
