This Amendment #01 is entered into by and between Clackamas County ("COUNTY") and Clackamas Women's Services ("SUBRECIPIENT") and will become a part of that subrecipient agreement (Agreement") originally entered by and between the parties on March 5, 2026.

This Amendment #01 extends the Agreement term through July 31, 2027, and adds to the maximum compensation available through this Agreement.


