**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:** The Clackamas County Public Health Division (CCPHD) of the Health, Housing & Human Services Department requests approval of a revenue Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas County Fire District #1 for reimbursement for access to the electronic patient care records (ePCRs) software.

Clackamas County's EMS Strategic Plan, approved by the Board of County Commissioners in December 2018, identifies equipment standardization as a prioritized need. The EMS Strategic Plan Taskforce has selected electronic patient care records (ePCRs) as the first step toward standardization. Standardization of this equipment has a significant benefit for patients by ensuring coordinated, high-quality care through interoperable technology. Amendment #1 provides next year's reimbursement.

This Amendment is effective January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve Amendment #1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement (10482) and authorize Chair Roberts or his designee to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

**AMENDMENT #1  
TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH  
CLACKAMAS COUNTY and CLACKAMAS FIRE DISTRICT #1  
FOR ESO ePCR REIMBURSEMENT  
Agreement #10482**

This Amendment #1 is entered into between Clackamas Fire District #1 ("Agency") and Clackamas County ("County") and shall become part of the Contract documents entered into between both parties on February 24, 2022, #10482("Agreement").

The Purpose of this Amendment #1 is to make the following changes to the Agreement:

1. Section 1, **Term** is hereby amended as follows:  
This Agreement shall be effective upon execution and shall expire upon the completion of each, and every obligation of the Parties set forth herein, or **December 31, 2026**, whichever is sooner..
2. Section 3, Consideration is hereby amended as follows:  
Consideration. The Agency agrees to pay County, from available and authorized funds, a sum not to exceed **One Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-three dollars and zero cents (\$136,653.00)** for accomplishing the Work required by this Agreement.
3. Section 4, Payment is hereby amended as follows:
