The purpose of the meeting will be to receive testimony from community members on the proposed Keys to Clackamas Down Payment Assistance Program. Clackamas County has a direct allocation award of \$7,747,747.00 in Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds (CDBG-DR funds) from the State of Oregon to assist areas impacted by the 2020 Wildfires.

Clackamas County plans to use this funding to provide 2020 wildfire impacted households and low-income households with Down Payment Assistance (DPA) for affordable homeownership opportunities through the repositioning of the Housing Authority of Clackamas County (HACC's) scattered site portfolio into Community-Land Trusts (CLT). Attendees can ask questions about the proposed project, the intended program outcomes and how the proposed project was selected for funding.
