The Parks Advisory Board, staffed by the Community Services, Parks Division, currently has 3 openings on their commission due to term resignations. 15 members are allowed with 4 year terms.

Recruitment opened to the public on October 8, 2025 and closed on January 8, 2026. Recruitment took place by press release, Facebook, Nextdoor, and the county website. Through this recruitment process, 11 applications were received and 3 were recommended to be appointed. 3 applicants are new and no applicants are currently on the board. Interviews were conducted with all eligible applicants.
