


Clackamas County Safe Routes to School 2026 Art Contest

Design a sign that encourages safe travel in areas around schools. Get your creative juices flowing and think of ways to **help make walking and biking to school safer.**


Up to three winners could have their art printed on **signs that will be distributed to schools, students, and families all across Clackamas County!**


EIGHT TIPS FOR A GREAT DESIGN

Easily seen by someone driving past.

Colorful



Something eye-catching. Fill up the space with plenty of color!

Includes Theme

*Entries must use one of **four** themes:*

*SLOW DOWN
DRIVE SAFE
DRIVE SLOW
DRIVE PHONE FREE*

The chosen theme should be clearly written in the exact words, in letters at least 2" tall.

Reproduceable



No glitter, stickers, or moving parts.

Creative




Show us your imaginative chops!

Doesn't mimic traffic signs



Leave the caution, speed limit, and stop signs to the engineers!

Correct Size



Landscape orientation on standard printer paper size. Either physical or digital submissions accepted.

Legible



Text should be easily readable. Don't hesitate to ask an adult for help!
