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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The Office of Economic Development, in collaboration with Public and Government Affairs (PGA), established a business spotlight video program in the Spring of 2025. These Video Spotlights will be made public on the County website, incorporated into the County's video media, shared by the Commissioners during business and other meetings and utilized by the business for their own professional marketing.

The Office of Economic Development and PGA committed to delivering one video per month over a 10-to-12-month period beginning October 2, 2025. A shortened version of each video will be presented publicly at a Business Meeting. The final video in the series is Bridgetown Mushrooms.

Founded in 2018 in Tigard, Oregon, Bridgetown Mushrooms is a USDA Organic culinary mushroom farm that cultivates fresh specialty mushrooms for distribution throughout the West Coast. Bridgetown is a 2024 grant recipient that received \$90,000 to support their relocation into unincorporated Canby and capital investments in equipment for the new space.
