May 20, 2025 Special District Election:

Clackamas County Clerk and Elections conducts federal, state, and local elections for all voters living in Clackamas County. The special district election includes local measures and candidates for local school, water, fire, and other special districts. Where you live determines what is on your ballot.

Important Dates:

- Feb. 10 – March 20 at 5 p.m. – Special district candidates can file for office.
- March 24 at 5 p.m. – Last day to submit a candidate statement or measure argument for inclusion in the voters' pamphlet.
- April 23 – April 25 – County voters' pamphlets are delivered to all residential addresses.
- April 29 – Voter Registration Deadline. Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office open until 7 p.m. to serve voters. Voters can register online at oregonvotes.gov.
- April 30 – Clackamas County Elections mails ballots. Official Ballot Drop Sites are opened.
- May 5 – Happy Valley Vote Center opens in the Happy Valley Library.
- May 8 – All eligible voters should have received their ballots. Contact Clackamas County Elections if you have not received your ballot.
- May 17 – Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office and Happy Valley Vote Center is open Saturday, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
- **Election Day, May 20** – The elections Oregon City office and Happy Valley Vote Center are open 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. Ballots must be mailed back with a valid postmark on or before Election Day or returned to an Official Ballot Drop Site before 8 p.m. on Election Day. Unofficial Elections Results will be posted at clackamas.us/elections starting at 8 p.m.
- June 13 – County Clerk certifies election.

Twenty-five Official Ballot Drop Sites:

The newest Official Ballot Drop Site is located at the Clackamas Community College – Oregon City Campus at 19600 Molalla Ave. The drop box is located in the student drop-off area, near the TriMet bus station and Orange parking lot by Rook Hall.

The ColtonTel Official Ballot Drop Site is temporarily closed due to construction at that location through December 2025. All Official Ballot Drop Sites are available until 8 p.m. on Election Day May 20 and are listed online: www.clackamas.us/elections/official-ballot-drop-sites

Two Voter Service Locations:

Each voter service location is staffed by sworn election officials. Voters can replace a lost or damaged ballot, update voter registration information, get voting assistance if they have a disability, get voting assistance in a preferred language, return their voted ballot, or vote in person.
