EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: County emergency management programs are required by Oregon Revised Statutes 401. The EMPG is a recurring federal grant program providing limited reimbursement of a portion of the costs incurred in operating local emergency management programs. The funds provided are for the development of an all-hazard emergency management capability to promote preparedness, mitigation, response and recovery. The grant provides \$151,140.50 of Federal funds, with a required 50% cost match that will be met using budgeted County General funds. The grant amendment extends the period of performance by three months.
