A Voter's Guide to the November 4, 2025 Special Election

Clackamas County Clerk and Elections conducts federal, state, and local elections for all voters living in Clackamas County. There will be a special election held on November 4, 2025. **This is not a county-wide election.** Where you live determines what is on your ballot. If you are a registered voter in the cities of Gladstone, Happy Valley, or Portland; the Sandy Fire District; or the Lake Oswego, Oregon Trail or West Linn – Wilsonville school districts you should expect a ballot in the mail.

Register to vote or update your voter registration information

Qualifications to be a voter in Oregon:

You can register to vote if you are a resident of Oregon, a citizen of the United States, and you are at least 16 years old. You will get your first ballot in the mail when you are at least 18 years old.

Register to vote: The Voter Registration Deadline is October 14, 2025.

- **Register to vote online** at the Oregon Secretary of State website <u>oregonvotes.gov</u>. You must have an Oregon driver's license or identification card to sign up online. The deadline to register to vote online is October 14, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.
- Register to vote by filling out a paper Oregon Voter Registration Card. You can get a
 paper card at the Clackamas County Elections office, your public library, Oregon
 Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) office, or post office. Your paper form must be
 returned to the elections office or mailed with a postmark no later than October 14.
 Clackamas County Elections will be open until 7 p.m. on the Voter Registration
 Deadline, October 14, 2025.

Sign up for Track Your Ballot!

Trust that your vote counts with simple, secure mail ballot tracking. Know where your ballot is in the voting process – from mailed to accepted.

As a Clackamas County voter, you can sign up to receive alerts via text, phone, or email. Know when your ballot is mailed to you. After you vote and return your ballot, be alerted when it has been accepted for counting. Your vote remains anonymous and confidential.

Sign up online for Track Your Ballot at <u>clackamas.us/elections/track-your-ballot</u>. This service is free for the voter.

Getting your ballot

Clackamas County Elections mails ballots to all eligible voters beginning Wednesday, October 15. If you do not receive your ballot by October 22, contact Clackamas County Elections for assistance.

Voters who will be away from home on Election Day can request an absentee ballot. Absentee ballots can be mailed to your temporary address or picked up at the elections office beginning September 22. Contact Clackamas County Elections to request an absentee ballot.

Two voter service locations to serve you!

Clackamas County Elections will open a pop-up vote center inside the Happy Valley Library starting October 20 for voters needing assistance. The **Happy Valley Vote Center** provides a closer choice for voters in Happy Valley, Sandy, Damascus and other north-east communities. Voters can choose the location that works best for them.

Each voter service location is staffed by sworn election officials. At the vote center citizens can replace a lost or damaged ballot, update voter registration information, get voting assistance if they have a disability, get voting assistance in a preferred language, return their voted ballot, or vote in person.

Twenty-two Official Ballot Drop Sites

Two ways to return your voted ballot - by mail or Official Ballot Drop Site

- Mail your voted ballot back with a valid postmark on or before Election Day, November 4, 2025. No stamp needed! We recommend returning your ballot directly to an Official Ballot Drop Site if you vote after Friday, October 31.
- 24-Hour Official Ballot Drop Sites are located throughout the county. You may deposit your ballot at any Official Ballot Drop Site in the state until 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 4, 2025. Find your nearest Official Ballot Drop Site below or at clackamas.us/elections.

- October 14 Voter Registration Deadline. Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office open until 7 p.m. to serve voters.
- October 15 Clackamas County Elections mails ballots to voters. Official Ballot Drop Sites are opened where there is a special election.
- October 20 Happy Valley Vote Center opens in the Happy Valley Library.
- October 22 All eligible voters should have received their ballots. Contact Clackamas County Elections if you have not received your ballot.
- November 1 Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office and Happy Valley Vote Center is open Saturday, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
- November 4 Election Day! Clackamas County Elections Oregon City office and Happy Valley Vote Center are open 7 a.m. – 8 pm. Unofficial Elections Results will be posted online at <u>clackamas.us/elections</u> starting at 8 p.m.
- December 1 County Clerk certifies election.
