Statement

 Provide the reasons for demanding recall in 200 words or less. Any factual information provided must be true.

We, the undersigned registered voters of the West Linn–Wilsonville School District, are calling for the recall of the above-named school board member due to concerns about inadequate oversight of the district, insufficient protection of taxpayer funds, and a lack of transparency with the public.

Before the November 2025 school bond election, the district told voters that the bond would fund improvements at all schools. After voters approved the bond, district leadership moved forward with plans to close two schools. As a result, the approved bond is larger than necessary and will require residents to pay higher taxes than needed.

The district reported receiving enrollment data on November 4, 2025, that began discussions on school closures. However, district officials publicly discussed possible closures on October 14, 2025. This board member did not seek clarification or ensure accountability.

These actions placed the bond and a \$6 million state matching grant at risk. Major decisions were made without clear information about class sizes, transportation, staffing, or school capacity. This lack of oversight undermined public trust and warrants recall.
