EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The Clackamas County Department of Transportation and Development applies and maintains road striping for the safety of those using County roads. It is vitally important that the County develop an agreement and maintain a supply of reflective beads to apply with its striping paint. Due to the short dry season in which the County operates, delivery times are crucial to the application of striping and maintaining a highly reflective surface for drivers. This contract covers glass beads to be dropped or sprayed upon longitudinal pavement markings to produce reflectorized pavement marking.

This is a two-year cooperative contract utilizing the State of Oregon Price Agreement # 9265. \$225,000.00 in funds will be spent each FY 25/26 and 26/27.

PROCUREMENT PROCESS: Approval of the purchase is being requested under the Local Contract Review Board Rule C-046-0400, Authority of Cooperative Procurements. The purchase will be made using State of Oregon Goods and Services prize agreement #9265 with Potters Industries LLC for Roadway Markings and Type II Glass Beads.

Whereas, the Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") has authority to sign all contracts and any amendments or renewals of the same;

Whereas, Oregon Revised Statutes ("ORS") Chapter 279A.200-220 and Local Contract Review Board Rule C-046-0400 permit Clackamas County to purchase goods or services using a cooperative procurement;

Whereas, Potters Industries, LLC established Cooperative Contract # 9265 with the State of Oregon for the purchase of roadway markings and paint glass beads ("Cooperative Contract");

Whereas, the Clackamas County Department of Transportation and Development desires to purchase roadway markings and paint glass beads (the "Goods") through the Cooperative Contract for a total contract price of \$450,000.00;

Whereas, the Clackamas County Department of Finance requests authority to utilize the Cooperative Contract to purchase the Goods by issuance of a purchase order ("PO");

Whereas, a PO is issued directly through the Department of Finance's management software with no signature required or available;

NOW THEREFORE, the Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners order as follows:

- 1. The requested use of the Cooperative Contract to purchase the Goods in the amount of \$450,000.00 is hereby approved;
- 2. The Clackamas County Department of Finance is hereby delegated limited authority to issue a PO to purchase the Goods using the Cooperative Contract.
