

## Appointed Boards and Commissions (ABCs) Recommendation

The Clackamas County Community Health Council, under the Health, Housing and Human Services Department, opened their recruitment for consumer and non-consumer representation. The Community Health Council has a federal grant requirement to maintain a majority of consumer members, and its by-laws require a minimum of nine members. This ABC holds a current roster of 7 members.

Members voted unanimously at the regularly scheduled meeting on May 21, 2025 to recommend new member, Rebecca Martin to serve her First term on the council.

Rebecca is a consumer member who has a personal interest in the quality of care provided by Health Centers. She is interested to see how the council handles consumer reviews and staff satisfaction. She believes that her experience in fraud prevention will be of value to the council. Rebecca is an advocate for equity in the healthcare system.

Our recommendation is as follows:

Rebecca Martin – Appointment to 1<sup>st</sup> term to end June 30, 2027

The Board of County Commissioners could select other candidates or require further recruitment.
