EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The Clackamas County Public Health Division (CCPHD) of the Health, Housing & Human Services Department requests the approval of a revenue Intergovernmental Agreement for reimbursement from the Colton Fire District for access to the electronic patient care records (ePCRs) software.

Clackamas County's EMS Strategic Plan, approved by the Board of County Commissioners in December 2018, identifies equipment standardization as a prioritized need. The EMS Strategic Plan Taskforce has selected electronic patient care records (ePCRs) as the first item towards standardization. Standardization of this equipment has a significant benefit for patients by ensuring coordinated, high-quality care through interoperable technology. Amendment #1 provides next year's reimbursement.

This Amendment is effective January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve Amendment #1 to the Intergovernmental Agreement (10490) and authorize Chair Roberts or his designee to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

1. Section 1, **Term** is hereby amended as follows:
This Agreement shall be effective upon execution and shall expire upon the completion of each, and every obligation of the Parties set forth herein, or **December 31, 2026**, whichever is sooner..
2. Section 3, Consideration is hereby amended as follows:
Consideration. The Agency agrees to pay County, from available and authorized funds, a sum not to exceed **Three Thousand One Hundred Ninety dollars and Sixty cents (\$3,190.60)** for accomplishing the Work required by this Agreement
3. Section 4, Payment is hereby amended as follows:


