STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- **1. Prior to the Hearing.** You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and talk to County Staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- **2. Procedure.** The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence; the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of evidence that a violation exists or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney, to represent that at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney, they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- <u>3. Record of Proceedings.</u> An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- **4. Hearings Officer.** The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed, the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a final order or a continuing order. The Hearings Officer Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon Law. - <u>5. Right to Recess.</u> If, during the course of the hearing, the Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceedings be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- **<u>6. Right to Appeal.</u>** The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearing Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, the appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Andrea Hall, Senior Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent Rose Minor's mailing address is: 20042 S Reflection Ln., Oregon City, OR 97045.

2.

The Respondent(s) own/owns or occupies the address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint 20042 S Reflection Ln., Oregon City, OR 97045, also known as T3S, R1E, Section 11, Tax Lot 1007, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon. The property is zoned Rural Residential Farm Forest 5-Acres (RRFF-5) and is the location of violation(s) asserted by the County.

3.

On or about the 26th day of March, 2025 and May 22, 2025 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Chapter 10.03.060(A)(B) for the accumulation of inoperable and/or non-currently

licensed vehicles on the subject property.

Page 1 of 3 – COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

This violation is a Priority 3 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

b. Section 316.03 of the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance for the operation of a home-based business without land use approval. This is a Priority 2 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

c. Chapter 9.02.040 for the construction of an accessory structure and placement of a tiny home on the property without permits or inspections. This is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

4.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner: Violation notice dated March 26, 2025 and Citation and Complaint #2400465. A copy of the notice documents are attached to this Complaint as Exhibit G & I, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for the Priority 1 violation being \$750.00 to \$1,000.00 per occurrence, said range for the Priority 2 violation being \$500.00 to \$2,500.00, said range for the Priority 3 violation being \$250.00 to \$1,500.00 as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;

3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code; and

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

5. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

History of Events and Exhibits:

December 9, 2024 Exhibit A	In response to a complaint, an alleged letter was mailed to the Respondent regarding an alleged accumulation of solid waste on the property.
December 23, 2024 Exhibit B	Per the Respondent's email, the vehicles are on her property on a temporary basis, they are being staged for a sale. She asked for clarification as to exactly what codes were being violated, the County sent her links to the code for her to review.
December 23, 2024 Exhibit C	A violation notice was mailed to the Respondent with a deadline of January 27, 2025 to abate the solid waste code violation.
January 27, 2025 Exhibit D	After receiving an additional complaint regarding a business operating from the property, research was done that revealed that I Go Greener was operating from the property. A second violation notice was mailed to the Respondent with a deadline of February 28, 2025 to submit a Home Occupation permit application to the Planning Department.
March 18, 2025 Exhibit E	A site visit was attempted but when staff tried to talk with two people on the property, we were told to leave which we did. Photos were taken from off the property.
March 18, 2025 Exhibit F	Email from Deputy Building Codes Administrator Michelle Amend, confirming that the boat shaped structure required a permit.
March 26, 2025 Exhibit G	An amended violation notice was mailed to the Respondent with a deadline of April 28, 2025 to abate the violation.
May 22, 2025 Exhibit H	A site visit was performed from off the property, the solid waste remains on the site.

May 29, 2025 Exhibit I A review of the County's permit system revealed that there were no permits for the commercial activity or accessory buildings. Citation number 2400465 was issued in the amount of \$700 for the solid waste and zoning violations, the building code violation was not subject to a fine amount. The citation was not returned to the County and it remains unpaid.

September 22, 2025 Exhibit J A site visit was performed which revealed the solid waste code violation remained. A review of County records revealed that there were no permits for the home-based business or accessory buildings.

November 12, 2025

The matter was referred to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the Solid Waste Management Code, Zoning and Development Ordinance and Building Code exist on the subject property, the County would request a Continuing Order be issued requiring the Respondent to do the following within 30 days of the date of the Order.

- Screen from view all items of solid waste you wish to keep and remove the remaining items to an authorized disposal facility and render all vehicles currently licensed and operable or remove them from the property. Two inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles may remain on the property but they must be screened from view from the road and adjacent properties.
- Submit a Home Occupation permit application to the Clackamas County Planning Department for any commercial activity on the property. Respond to requests for clarification or additional information from permitting staff within 15 days of receiving such request. If approved, meet all conditions of approval within 60 days. If the application is denied, the business must cease operating from the property within 60 days of the denial.
- Submit building permit applications for the boat structure and the additional dwelling. Requests for additional information must be responded to within 10 days from the date of the request. The permit must have the fees paid in full within ten days of being notified the permit is ready. Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of the permit being issued.

The County will submit a timely Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:

- O Payment of Citation 2400465 dated May 29, 2025 in the amount of \$700.00 for the priority 3 solid waste and priority 2 zoning violations.
- o The imposition of civil penalties of \$250.00 to \$1,500.00 for the priority 3 solid waste code violation.
- The imposition of civil penalties of \$500.00 to \$2,500.00 for the priority 2 zoning violation.
- The imposition of \$750.00 to \$1,000.00 for the priority 1 building code violation.
- O The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from December 2024 which is \$850.00, however, the County is requesting \$500.00 as a reasonable estimate of the cost of this enforcement matter.
- If the violations are not abated the County may request authorization for further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.
- The County requests the Hearing's Officer to permanently enjoin the Respondent from violating these laws in the future.

Important Notices

- Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- 2. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
- 3. Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. Potential Fines and Penalties: The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property: Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
