RE: Board Nomination to Metro Regional Waste Advisory Committee

DATE: September 3, 2025

**REQUEST:** Board decision on Regional Waste Advisory Committee nomination.

**BACKGROUND:** A seat reserved for local government on the Metro Regional Waste Advisory Committee (RWAC) is open for nominations. The Metro Council created the RWAC in 2024 to:

- Implement key regional garbage and recycling plans, including the 2030
  Regional Waste Plan and the Regional System Facilities Plan (which includes
  planned investments in a new transfer station to replace the Metro South facility
  in Oregon City).
- Oversee Metro's Waste Prevention and Environmental Services budget.
  - o This includes review of annual adjustments to regional solid waste fees.
- Take on other planning responsibilities for the regional garbage and recycling system as required by state law or assigned by Metro Council.

Currently, two RWAC members represent portions of Clackamas County: Oregon City Mayor Denyse McGriff and Metro Councilor Christine Lewis. Full RWAC membership is listed in Attachment A. The group meets monthly from 2-4pm on the fourth Thursday.

Although the Board may nominate a representative, Metro makes the final decision for appointments to the RWAC. The Board previously nominated former Commissioner Mark Shull to be considered for membership, but Metro did not appoint him.

The deadline for submitting a nomination for this two-year term position is Friday, September 5, 2025.

The Board has two options: take no action (the County would continue to be represented on RWAC by Mayor McGriff and Councilor Lewis) or identify a member of the Board to nominate for the position.

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality member will serve until a replacement is nominated by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality executive. The remaining members will serve for a term of two (2) years.
