Approval of an Amendment to a Personal Services Contract with Catholic Community Services of Western Washington for child behavioral health stabilization services. Amendment rescinds \$727,082 and increase time by 1 year. Total Contract Value is decreased to \$727,082 for 27 months. Funding is through Oregon Health Authority. No County General Funds are involved.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**: The Behavioral Health Division of the Health, Housing, and Human Services Department requests the approval of an Amendment to a personal services contract with Catholic Community Services of Western Washington (CCSWW) for Mobile Response and Stabilization Services for children and individuals up to twenty (20) years of age and their families. Stabilization services are designed to maintain the child/individual in their current living arrangement, prevent unnecessary emergency room visits and hospitalizations, stabilize behavioral health needs, and improve functioning in various life domains.

Following the review of Contract expenditures and discussions with CCSWW, it was determined that the maximum value of the contract and the service rates required adjustment. Amendment #01 rescinds \$727,082.00 originally authorized through the original Contract, while the service rates for 56-day authorizations and 28-day authorization extensions are being increased. This Amendment #01 also extends the term of the Contract twelve (12) months, through June 30, 2027, and has a decreased Contract maximum value of \$727,082.00 for twenty-seven (27) months.

Catholic Community Services of Western Washington (CCS) was the contracted provider for the Crisis and Acute Transition Services (CATS) program, which the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) retired on December 31, 2022. OHA introduced the new statewide Mobile Response and Stabilization Services program on January 1, 2023. The Behavioral Health Division requested and was granted a sole-source designation that allowed CCS to be awarded the contract for Stabilization Services for the one-year pilot project period. Near the end of the one-year pilot project period, a formal procurement was conducted for the provision of continued Mobile Response and Stabilization Services.

This Contract was awarded following a request for proposals (RFP) procurement process. This project was advertised in accordance with ORS and OCRB Rules on October 16, 2023, through RFP 2023-89. Proposals were publicly opened on November 15, 2023. The County received one (1) proposal. Following review of the proposal, it was determined to be in the County's best

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interest to award the Contract to Catholic Community Services of Western Washington.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve this Amendment (11547) and authorize Chair Roberts or his designee to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

## **AMENDMENT #1**

This Amendment #1 is entered into between **Catholic Community Services of Western Washington** ("Contractor") and Clackamas County ("County") and shall become part of the Contract documents entered into between both parties on **June 27, 2024** ("Contract").

The Purpose of this Amendment #1 is to make the following changes to the Contract:

- 1. ARTICLE I, Section 1. **Effective Date and Duration** is hereby amended as follows: The Contract termination date is hereby changed from June 30, 2025 to **June 30, 2026.**
- 2. ARTICLE I, Section 6. Contract Documents is hereby amended as follows: Exhibit C of the Contract is hereby replaced in its entirety by Exhibit C attached to this Amendment #1 and incorporated herein.
- 3. ARTICLE I, Section 3. Consideration is hereby amended as follows:

  Due to the service levels not requiring the total amount of funding originally allocated for the
  Work, the total Contract value is reduced by \$727,082.00 of the original compensation amount of
  \$1,454,164.00. The maximum amount County shall compensate Contractor is an amount not to
  exceed \$727,082.00.
